ENVIRONMENTAL AWARD RECEIVED - Alan Savage, president, reports New Canamin

Resources Ltd.has received the B.C. Ministry of Energy Mines and Petroleum Resources provincial reclamation award for "reclamation of an exploration project" for its 1992 diamond drilling based exploration program on its Huckleberry porphyry copper property 25 km from Kemano, B.C.. New Canamin thanks its staff; its consulting geologists, Ainsworth-Jenkins Ltd. and its contract diamond driller, J.T. Thomas Diamond Drilling Ltd. for their contribution to this environmentally and economically successful program.

New Canamin also reports it has received postive public response from open house presentations in Smithers, Houston and Burns Lake, B.C. Of 148 people polled, 85.1% were in favour of the project, 12.9% were undecided and 2.0% indicated they were opposed.

Finally, an eight-hole evaluation of the "East zone", discovered by the drilling of a water quality monitoring well 4,000 feet from the "Main Zone", indicates that the discovery has now expanded to some 8.000,000 tonnes grading 0.69% copper. This discovery continues to grow in response to an ongoing 10,000 foot diamond drilling program. New Canamin can earn a 100% interest in the project from Kennecott by spending \$1,500,000 over five years; Kennecott can back-in for 60%.
