WINTER EXPLORATION PLANNED - Hugh Grenfal, president, reports due to the success of the summer

exploration program Booker Gold Explorations Ltd. will continue exploration of the Hearne Hill property through the winter. The property is in the Babine District of B.C., 65 km northeast of Smithers and 21 km north of Noranda's Bell mine. There is excellent year-round road access and it is understood that a major company will soon be starting a drill program nearby. Booker Gold can earn a 100% interest subject to a 4.5% NSR.

The summer /fall program has produced excellent results both geophysically and geologically. The original breccia pipe has been studied and a magnetometer survey has proven to be the definitive exploration tool. The Chapman zone was drilled at -60°, azimuth north, by percussion drill. The hole averaged 2.08% copper and 0.02 oz. gold /ton over 250 feet. A previous diamond drill hole 100 feet north was drilled at -45°, azimuth ENE. The hole averaged 2.21% copper and 0.04 oz.gold/ton over 250 feet. A trench across the pipe assayed 2.3% copper and 0.012 oz.gold/ton across 85 feet. A trench 100 feet NE of the pipe cut altered volcanic and assayed 1.5% copper and 0.02 oz.gold/ton across 30 feet. A new magnetic anomaly in an area of intrusive and altered volcanic has been located 600 feet east of the Chapman Zone. The new anomaly has an almost identical magnetic signature as the Chapman zone and appears to be twice as wide. A detailed magnetometer survey across the balance of the property is now being mobilized. Upon its completion the company will diamond drill all magnetic targets.
