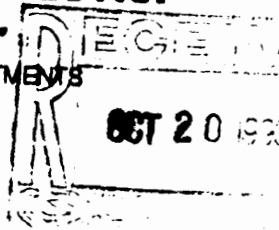

GOLD EXPLORATION UPDATE - Hugh Ross, president, Winslow Gold Corp. and its 50% joint venture partner Gentry Resources Ltd. have reported the 1993 exploration program on their Engineer Mine property has now been completed. The Engineer Mine is located on Tagish Lake, about 35 km west of Atlin, B.C. Winslow and Gentry have entered into an agreement with Ampex Mining which has an option to earn a 50% interest in the property by spending \$500,000 on exploration.

The 1993 exploration program centered around reactivating the mine. Ampex rebuilt the portal to the main haulage level and refurbished about 1,600 feet of drift to the northeast to gain access to the Governor vein. Access gained to the vein has previously been inaccessible since the late 1920's. Old tract and air lines were removed and ventilation has been established along the main haulage tunnel to the Engineer vein. A small stoping operation was undertaken in the Governor vein at the 524 stope. On surface, the camp and machine shop areas were also improved, and there has been some trenching on the Shaft vein.

Old records from the 1920's state 18,400 tons of ore were milled from the Engineer Mine which resulted in 19,637 ounces gold being
