## GUARDIAN ENTERPRISES LTD. (GUD-V)

LA CLAIMS DRILL RESULTS - Len J. Harris, president, reports Guardian Enterprises Ltd. has received drilling results from the 100%-owned LA 1-20 claims in the Lillooet Mining Division, near Pemberton, B.C. Diamond drill holes LA 94-1 to LA 94-5 have been completed. A total of 2300 feet was drilled. All five holes were drilled on one (of its four) zones.

All five holes contained sulphide mineralization upon entering bedrock through to completion. Sulphide content is estimated at 10% in all the core in all five holes except for bands (2.5 to 50 feet thick) of heavy sulphide mineralization estimated at 15% to 30%. Visible sulphides include pyrite, calcopyrite and sphalerite (iron, copper, zinc). Extensive quartz veining is present in this zone.

In conclusion, several heavy sulphide mineral zones encountered with drilling a siliceous-pyrite sericite altered rhyolite/rhyodacite. The best assay value encountered was 2.5 feet of 0.85% copper, 0.38% zinc, 7.0 grams silver/tonne and 0.1 grams gold/tonne. This mineralization occurs as epigenetic, late-stage vein and/or replacement textures. Ten to 40-foot wide zones of 10 to 20% diagenetic pyrite occur in close proximity with the vein replacement base metal mineralization.

Further work recommended includes five 600 to 800-foot holes on 1,300 feet of untested strike length and five similar holes on three other mineralized zones that have been identified on the property. One new zone known as the "skerls" zone has a 2,200-foot strike length and contain rhodenite outcrops. This zone will be the focus on the next exploration program. No date has been set for resumption.

Guardian plans to start a work program in the "Golden Triangle" area of northwestern B.C. by August 20th. (SEE GCNL NO.100, 26May94, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS PROJECT INFORMATION)
