FIRESTEEL RESOURCES INC. (FTR-ALBERTA)
TULSEQUAH DRILLING COMPLETED - David G. DuPré, president,
Firesteel Resources Inc.,
has reported the completion of a 10-hole drilling program on the
100%-owned ZO property in the Tulsequah region of northwestern
B.C. The target is a mineralized shear zone containing impressive
values for gold, silver, lead, zinc and antimony. This shear zone is
at least 360 meters long, up to 15 meters thick and is highlighted by
a 2-metre chip sample which assayed 0.239 oz. gold/ton, 14.28 oz.
silver/ ton, 4.38% lead, 5.04% zinc and 2.66% antimony.
All of the drill holes intersected the altered and mineralized
shear zone. Nine of the holes intersected massive to semi-massive
sulphides over true thicknesses of up to 2.6 meters which are
enveloped by moderately mineralized alteration zones. The assays
will likely be available the last week of August.
The drill has been left on site in anticipation of encouraging
results. In such a case a second phase of drilling will be initiated in
