LARGE PORPHYRY MINERAL - International Skyline Gold reports
INVENTORY OUTLINED drilling on the company's Bronson

Slope property in northwest B.C. has outlined a large gold/copper/molybdenum porphyry mineral inventory. SEE MAP OVERLEAF P.2. This resource has little overburden and appears to be mineable using an open cut mining method. The mineralized zone is open in three directions, one of which is where the increased gold and copper grades are located. Additional drilling will be required to extend the limits of the currently known resource.

These results were derived from 2,855 feet of drilling completed in the fall of 1993, together with data from 7,461 feet of drilling previously available to the company. The drilling data resulted in the mineral inventory listed in the table overleaf P.2.

Copper/gold porphyry deposits such as the Bronson Slope porphyry typically contain higher grade zones within or associated with the larger, low grade resource. Cominco/Homestake's neighbouring high grade Snip gold mine is located in the precious metal halo of the Bronson Slope porphyry. Geochemical and geological surveys indicate potential for similar high grade deposits within the porphyry system. Individual mineralized structures

encountered in the drilling have assayed as high as 0.452 oz. gold/ton and 9.40% copper, over un reported widths.

The drilling data is being compiled into a database. For planning purposes the company is modelling a 4,000,000 tons per year or a 12,000 ton-per-day conventional mine and mill facility producing a copper/gold concentrate.

The capital cost of infrastructure may be lowered by comparison with other deposits in B.C. due to its convenient access to Alaskan power and deep sea facilities located on the Bradfield Canal, 37 miles southwest of the property. The Eskay Creek road, connecting to Highway 37, is 19 miles up the Iskut River Valley to the east.

The company plans to spend \$200,000 on exploration in 1994 season with the objectives of increasing the size of the mineral inventory, locating the highest grade zones and delineating a mineable reserve. This will be followed up with a preliminary economic evaluation of the deposit. The deposit is estimated to be a minimum of 86,000,000 tons of an average grade of 0.01 oz. of gold per ton, 0.16% copper and 0.013% molybdenum, equal to about Can. \$6.50 per ton gross value. 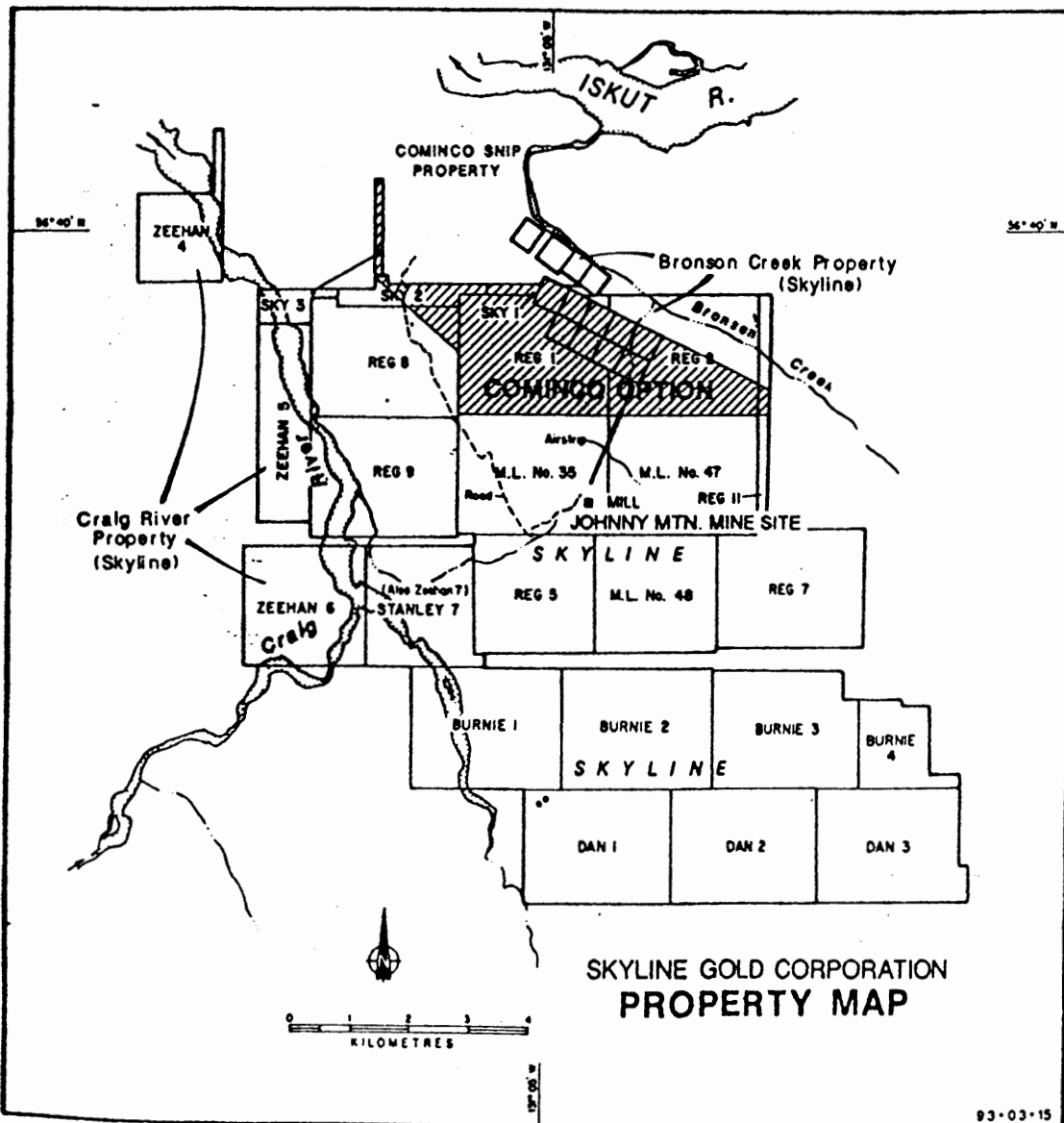
