The Cliff project is the principal mineral asset of the company and exploration for 1994 is planned with follow-up work scheduled based on the 1993 exploration results. The main target is the Cliff Zone (SEE MAP OVERLEAF P.2) which has a strike length of over 2,100 metres. The Cliff Zone originates at the Sheppard Showing located at 1,960 feet elevation and trends southwest to elevations of 4,500 feet. Surface sampling along the zone has located gold values ranging from 0.01 to 0.11 oz/ton with associated silver and copper values of significance.
