## DALMATIAN RESOURCES LTD.

FURTHER GEOPHYSICAL WORK - Frank Milakovich, president of Dalmatian Resources Ltd., has reported additional exploration PLANNED FOR TAY PROJECT funding has been proposed for its 100%-owned Tay project and associated land holdings located 40 km west of Port Alberni, Vancouver Island, B.C. Mr. Milakovich has proposed to sell privately 600,000 of his owned shares of Dalmatian and use the proceeds to exercise options and warrants he currently holds. He stated discussion have been held with potential buyers but a sale has not yet been completed. (See GCNL NO.133, 13Jul94, P.7 for details) Approval has been received for a helicopter-borne, multi-instrument geophysical survey to evaluate Dalmatian's 3,200-hectare (7,900 acres) comprising; the Tay claims, Sunrise claims, Diane claims, and the privately-held adjacent Nora claims.

Approval has also been given for the detailed mapping and trenching of the Tay Centre and Tay West areas where gold values of 13 grams gold/tonne (0.46 oz/ton) and 26.6 grams gold/tonne (0.94 oz/ton) respectively have been recorded. Trenching and mapping will be followed by several specific targets for diamond drilling.

In addition, initial exploration will be undertaken in the Knob, Apex, Diane and Sunrise in preparation for a Phase 2 Exploration Program. The Knob zone contains a large induced polarization anomaly extending north and east. The Apex zone has a mineralized zone up to 7 meters (23 feet) in width and extends into the Tay zone. The Diane zone has an extensive area of anomalous zinc, lead, mercury and gold mineralization. Rock samples yielded gold values of over 17 grams gold/tonne (0.60 oz/ton). The Sunrise zone historic records have reported gold values up to 25 grams gold/tonne (0.88 oz/ton). This zone consists of an area in excess of 4,000 metres (13,123 feet) by 600 metres (1,969 feet).
