B.C. DRILLING UNDERWAY - John G. Robertson, president, Teryl Resources Corp., has reported the start of the 10-hole drilling program on the Mt. Sidney Williams gold property located 87 km northwest of Fort St. James, and 187 km northwest of Prince George, central B.C. Teryl can earn a 100% interest, subject to a 2% NSR, by making \$210,000 in option payments, and spending \$1,500,000 on exploration over five years.

Drill hole B.C.94-1, totalling 215 feet was completed on 13Jul94. The hole was drilled to test a coincident arsenic/ gold/ copper soil geochem anomaly and an induced polarization charged anomaly. According to Teryl's geologist, a visual inspection of the drill hole showed that the entire 215 feet drilled was mineralized, with the top 90 feet averaging 10% sulphide (pyrite, chalcopyrite, bornite and arsenopyrite). From 90 - 215 feet disseminated chalcopyrite and pyrite, averaging about 1% were noted. The hole was still in mineralization at 215 feet. Drilling has started on B.C. 94-2, a 600-foot step-out on the same anomaly. Assay results are expected the last week of July.

An independent report on the 13,755-acre property suggests the existence of an extensive low grade tonnage deposit similar to the Timmins, Ontario and Kalgoorlie, Australia gold camp. (SEE GCNL NO.94, 17May94, P.4 FOR PREVIOUS PROJECT INFORMATION)
