GOOD GOLD AT TAY PROJECT - Frank Malakovich, president, reports Dalmatian Resources Ltd. has received further assays from the 100%-owned Tay gold project located 40 km west of Port Alberni, Vancouver Island, B.C. More extensive evaluations of hole No.8 returned 0.78 oz. gold/ton over a true width of 30.6 feet. The Tay structures (Tay West, Tay Center, Tay Main, Tay East) are about one mile in length (1,675 meters). The Phase one drilling on 300 meters gave significant results; see table above and map overleaf P.3.

Holes 94-8, 9, 12 and 15 values are representative of mineralization for a linear distance of 300 meters on the Tay Main structure. Holes 94-8 and 9 demonstrate the significant economic potential of a higher grade Eastern Tay gold occurrence over an approximate linear distance of 300 meters. Holes 94-04, 12, 15 enforces previous findings of a lower but economical grade of the westerly trending Tay Zone. Historical exploration of Tay Center has returned values of up to 1.3 oz.gold/ton. Tay West has an open-ended soil anomaly at the extreme west end of the property. Vein mineralization of the adjacent Nora claims report up to 0.94 oz. gold/ ton. Approximate linear distance from the Tay Center to Tay West/Nora boundary is 625 meters. Approval for phase one extension has been received from the B.C.
