147 FEET OF 2.192% COPPER CUT - Alan Savage, president, reports New Canamin

Resources Ltd. has received further assay results from in-fill drilling the East zone of the 100%-owned Huckleberry copper project located about 100 km southeast of Kitimat. B.C.. These exceptional assay results further confirm the near-surface, high grade core of the East zone deposit. The company expects to complete reserve definition drilling for feasibility in the next few weeks and then begin exploration drilling on a 400 by 1,000-metre gold/copper anomaly situated north and east of the East zone.
