HUCKLEBERRY DRILL RESULTS - Alan C. Savage, president, reports New Canamin Resources Ltd. has

received assays from drill holes No. 94-104 drilled vertical and No. 94-105 drilled from the same location at -45° north in the Main zone at the 100%-owned Huckleberry project located 70 km east of Kemano. B.C. Holes 94-104 and 94-105 are step-out holes beyond the southwest end of previously defined near-surface mineralization in the Main Zone. These holes are about 150 metres (500 feet) west-south-west of holes 73-12 and 92-14 which had intersected higher grade (>0.50% copper) from surface.

A previous hole (DDH-2) drilled by Kennco in 1964, indicated the potential for extension of near-surface higher grade mineralization towards the west. Holes 94-104 and 94-105 were designed to test this possibility. This extension zone has an indicated width of 70-80 meters and is open to the west and back towards holes 73-12 and 92-14.
