MORE HUCKLEBERRY ASSAYS - Alan C. Savage, president, reports New Canamin Resources Ltd. has

received further assays from diamond drilling on the 100%-owned Huckleberry copper project located 70 miles east of Kemano. B.C. Hole 94-115 was drilled to a depth of 230 feet in weakly mineralized rock 200 feet east of hole 94-114, reported in GCNL NO.50, 14Mar94, P.1. Hole 94-117 was drilled 100 feet east of hole 93-11 (0.53% copper over 480 feet). Hole 94-116 was drilled a further 164 feet east of 94-117. Both holes have extended the Main zone deposit to the east, although 94-116 probably represents an eatern boundary. All the current Main zone drilling is on the periphery of the Main zone deposit and is designed to establish the limits of economic mineralization to enable an efficient pit design, a mining plan to be developed and waste rock volumes to be calculated.

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
