MORE HUCKLEBERRY ASSAYS - Alan C. Savage, president, New Canamin Resources Ltd. has reported Main Zone drilling for pit limits continues to yield encouraging results at the 100%-owned Huckleberry copper project 70 miles east of Kemano, B.C. DDH 94-118 was drilled vertically 200 ft southeast of No. 117 (0.76% copper over 450 ft) and recorded 0.60% copper for its first 50 feet. DDH 94-121 drilled at -45° W on the other (west) side of the deposit recorded 70 feet of 0.97% copper before reaching the granodiorite contact. DDH 94-123, drilled at -45° W 400 feet north-northwest of No.121 added 75 feet of margin in that area grading 0.44% copper. Hole 94-120 was drilled 100 feet east of No. 118 and did not carry economic mineralization. In the East Zone, hole 94-122 was drilled at -60° on section with No. 93-38 (0.65% copper over 370 ft).

With two drills on the property producing up to 500 feet of core per shift, information is being accumulated rapidly. The company has elected to report all drilling as results are available and will provide a summary report as soon as there is a pause in the program.
