## INTERNATIONAL SKYLINE GOLD CORP.

RESERVES REVISED UPWARDS - Clifford Grandison, president,  
reports International Skyline

Gold Corp.'s mineral resource estimate for its Bronson Slope gold/copper porphyry deposit on the Iskut River property in northwest B.C. has been revised upwards based on a computerized polygonal model. This resource is now estimated to be 112,000,000 tons of 0.019 oz. gold/ton, 0.14% copper, 0.10 oz. silver/ton and 0.01% molybdenum, using a search radius of 250 meters, containing 2,000,000 ounces of gold, 300,000,000 pounds of copper, 11,000,000 ounces of silver and 22,000,000 pounds of molybdenum. Included in these estimates are drill-indicated probable and possible resource of 40,000,000 tons of 0.019 oz. gold/ton, 0.16% copper, 0.10 oz. silver/ton and 0.01% molybdenum using a search radius of 100 metres and a \$10 per ton cut off. The average value per ton is calculated to be \$14.44. Samples have been submitted to determine recovery for gold and copper. Samples containing 0.16% copper yielded 85% of copper contained and samples containing 0.013 oz. gold/ton yielded 75-80% of gold contained in a gold/copper concentrate grading 23% copper and 1.46 oz. gold/ton. The tailings were said to appear to be benign.

Thirty-one holes have been drilled on the resource, which contains high grade zones set in continuous mineralization, is located close to surface and is open in three directions. A program of 1,000 metres is planned for July. (SEE GCNL NO.64, 5Apr94, P.4 FOR MEXICAN AZTEC PROJECT INFORMATION)
