METALL DROPS SENECA OPTION - Richard J. Bailes, vice president, reports International Curator Resources Ltd. has been informed Metall Mining Corp. has dropped its option on the Seneca property, located 100 km east of Vancouver, B.C. The Seneca property is a polymetallic massive sulphide deposit which has reserves of 1,510,000 tonnes grading 3.57% zinc, 0.65% copper, 41.4 grams silver/tonne and 0.82 grams gold/tonne in the Seneca Zone. The Fleetwood Zone, which occurs about three km northwest of the Seneca Zone, has massive sulphide intercepts grading as high as 28.1% zinc, 2.2% copper, 2.5% lead, 160.2 grams silver/tonne and 3.97 grams gold/tonne over 1.95 meters. No mineral resource has been calculated on the Fleetwood Zone due to wide spaced drilling and lack of hole-to-hole continuity.

International Curator owns a 50% interest in the Seneca property. The company can earn a further 50% interest from GRANGES INC. [GXL-T, AMEX] by making total cash payments of \$300,000, of which \$190,000 has been paid, \$50,000 is payable by 31Dec94 and \$60,000 is payable by 31Dec95. It is the intention of International Curator to make the above payments and to continue to explore and develop the mineral reserves on the Seneca property.
