GOOD GOLD CUT AT FRANKLIN - Nigel Stonestreet, P.Eng.,  
director, Sway Resources  
Inc., reports diamond drill results from the 100%-controlled Franklin  
Camp mineral claims, 44 miles north of Grand Forks, southeast B.C.

See table below. The first hole, 94 IXL No.1, (discovery hole)  
located on the northern extension of the Republic Graben, returned a  
25-foot intersection from 81 to 106 feet averaging 1.008 oz.  
gold/ton. Fire assays were conducted at Chemex Labs.

Another intersection of 5.0 feet from 201 to 206 feet assayed  
0.424 oz.gold/ton. Results from this hole are incomplete. The  
remaining core is being split and assayed.

The current drill program is designed to test surface geochemical  
and geophysical gold related anomalies that lie within an extensive  
area of mineralization and alteration with suitable lithologies  
favourable to gold deposition. This discovery is considered similar  
and typical of other gold deposits located within the Republic  
Graben area of northern Washington State.

The unoxidized ore zone appears to be a silicified and pyritized  
elastic sediment dome capped by a Tertiary conglomerate. The  
silicified-pyritized zone of alteration is extensive along and adjacent  
to the capping for 4,000 feet. Additional drilling is continuing on a  
24-hour basis. Further results will be reported as received. (SEE
