Resource Corp. has received the results of a
recently completed program of geological mapping, prospecting,
detailed magnetic and VLF-EM surveying and about 450 meters of
diamond drilling in six holes on the Juliet property, Nicola Mining
Division, southern B.C. Prospecting and geological mapping

focused on a coincident zinc/molybdenum/copper/lead-in-soils geochemical anomaly. The soil anomaly was found to be underlain by altered breccia which returned weakly anomalous gold, copper and molybdenum values. Magnetic surveys were inconclusive, with little magnetic relief indicated. The VLF-EM survey showed several weak to moderately anomalous responses.

Diamond drill holes ranged from 57 to 96 metres in length and tested areas of quartz stockworks, breecia, and copper-in-soil geochemical anoalies. Several zones of quartz stockwork were intersected and are weakly mineralized with trace amounts of chalcopyrite and molybdenite. Analytical results returned weakly anomalous copper and gold values.
