ENCOURAGING LORRAINE ASSAYS - Lou Duarte, president, reports
Lysander Gold Corp.

has received encouraging assay results from drilling on the Lorraine property near Germansen Landing, north-central B.C. Lysander holds an option to earn a 100% interest from Kennecott. Assays have been received for holes L94-1, 2 and 3 in the Bishop (Extension) zone and one hole, L94-8, from the Upper Main zone. The three holes in the Bishop zone (Upper Section) were drilled from one station. A fourth hole, L94-4, drilled to the north from the same site, passed through a fault and did not intersect the Bishop zone. Hole L94-5 was drilled 330 feet south of L94-1 and holes L94-6 and 7 were drilled an additional 330 feet to the south; assays are pending.

In the Upper Main zone, assays over 3-m sections varied from 0.52% to 2.4% copper and from 0.005 to 0.067 oz. gold/ ton. The hole bottomed in 1.36% copper and 0.01 oz.gold/ton.
