SB PROJECT DRILLING STARTS - Donald A. McLeod, president, Tenajon Resources Corp., has reported, together with its 50/50 joint venture partner, Westmin Resources Ltd., the development portion of the underground exploration program on the Kansas/West Kansas Zone has been completed and the drilling phase has now begun at the SB gold property located 35 km north of Stewart, B.C.

A total of 140 metres of additional strike length was made accessible for underground diamond drilling by completing in excess of 150 metres of drifting on the 895-metre sublevel during the present program. In 1993, exploration of 50 metres of strike length outlined a bulk mineable zone of 312,700 tonnes at an average grade of 3.07grams gold/tonne.

Diamond drilling is underway with two machines testing the newly accessible strike length at 20-metre intervals. A total of 2,860 metres of drilling is planned. Early drilling results indicate widespread quartz breccia and silicification is present for the entire 140 metres of additional strike length. In addition, a hole drilled into the face along strike at the end of the 1994 development heading intersected 80 metres of quartz breccia and silicified andesite. Taken together with the underground workings, this hole indicates the silicified zone has a strike length over 280 metres.

Widespread low grade gold values are being encountered in the KWK Zone along with erratic occurrences of visible gold with associated high grade gold values. Drilling is expected to be completed in early November. A bulk sample comprising the development material from the subdrift will be milled at Westmin's nearby Premier Gold Mill in November.
