TAURUS DRILL RESULTS REPORTED - David Hjerpe, president, International Taurus Resources Inc., and Hera Resources Inc., has reported Phases II and III of the underground development and exploration program at the Taurus minesite near Cassiar, northern B.C., are proceeding on schedule. Crosscutting has been completed to the 93-1 and 93-1 South Veins and drifting and sampling has begun.

Diamond drilling of the geophysical anomalies and trenced showings has proceeded as scheduled. Hole 56 encountered a zone of mineralized quartz stockwork. Drilling to date has confirmed a significant new zone of mineralization. The mineralization consists of very fine grained pyrite in silicified volcanics of the Sylvester Group. The drilling has indicated several flat or shallow-dipping zones of strongly pyritic (almost massive) mineralization with interbedded greenstones. The individual zones of mineralization are from a few feet to over 300 feet thick. Some stockwork development has occurred within the area of mineralization.

To date, 11 holes have been drilled to 550 ft. vertically. Mineralized zones with interbedded mineralization have been cut from surface to 500 feet in depth. A summary of hole 56 - 61 are reported overleaf P.3. The remaining holes drilled will be reported .

There is increasing evidence to suggest the new zone extends beneath much of the area previously drilled. Similar material was encountered in the lowest level of the Taurus mine. Continuity with the present discovery would indicate a strike length potential of 4,500 feet. A review of archival data and old drill core suggests similar mineralization 1,000 feet southeast of Hole 56. Additional potential exists on as yet untested portions of the property.

Mineralized zones of the type and style revealed in the recent drilling lend themselves to the development of open pit or bulk tonnage mining methods. Additional drilling is underway to determine the extent and grade of the new discovery. (Hera owns 56% of International Taurus, which owns 100% interests in the 31 Sable claims and has optioned 10 more claims. (SEE GCNL NO.197, Oct.6/94, P.5 FOR PREVIOUS PROJECT INFORMATION)
