NEW MINERAL SHOWINGS FOUND - Dino Cremonese, P.Eng., president, Teuton Resources Corp., and partner Minvita Enterprises Ltd. report reconnaissance programs underway since mid-July have resulted in the discovery of several new mineral occurrences. The companies are joint owners of a 100,000+ acre claim block situated between the Red Mountain and Kitsault mining districts located east and

Southeast of Stewart, northwest B.C.

One of these, the Konkin Silver Zone, features quartz, carbonate, barite, galena, sphalerite, ruby and native silver in a bow-shaped exposure covering a span of about 35 metres. The style of occurrence and the mineralogy are very similar to deposits in the Dolly Varden and Torbrit mines, former silver producers in the Kitsault district to the south.

The weighted average of nine one-metre chip samples taken across the eastern limb of the Konkin Silver exposure is 34.9 oz.silver/ton, 2.30% lead and 2.02% zinc. Included in the central portion of this interval is a six-metre span averaging 49.8 oz.silver/ton, 3.38% lead and 2.46% lead. There is a good possibility that further bow-like structures will be located in the host carbonate-altered rocks extending more than 300 metres to the south.
