VISIBLE MOLY FLOAT TRAIN FOUND - Larry Reaugh, president,
reports Dean Webb, P.
Eng., has advised Amcorp Industries and Verdstone Gold a jagged

rock float train containing visible molybdenum in disseminated globs and fractures was found during mapping on the companies' moly property 15 miles south of the past-producing Brenda Mine, 14 miles northwest of Peachland in the Okanagan, B.C. The float train, measuring about 35 feet wide by 150 feet long, is 1,000 feet north west of the 12 feet by 60 feet trench with grades up to 2.5% molybdenum. Mr. Webb reports the mineralized rock is jagged and appears to have broken off bedrock and dragged to the surface by the root systems of wind-felled trees. Samples from the float train are being submitted for assays prior to trenching. The train was found close to the top of the ridge and appears to have travelled little. The new showing corresponds to a recently completed magnetometer survey low which is the setting for the other mineralized occurrences in the area.

Currently, Discovery Consultants of Vernon, B.C., are conducting line cutting and soil survey's on five separate locations on the 7,700-acre property. Results will be reported.

A magnetometer survey over an area measuring 1,000 feet by 2,000 feet covering the area of mineralized outcropping has been performed and is being compiled. (SEE GCNL NO.141, 24Jul95, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS PROJECT INFORMATION)
