NEW GOLD DISCOVERY - Louis Wolfin, president, Bralorne Pioneer  
AT BRALORNE PROJECT Gold Mines Ltd. and 50/50 joint venture  
partner International Avino Mines Ltd.  
report recent excavator trenching on the north-east side of the  
Bralorne property uncovered a new gold-bearing zone to be called the

Maddy Zone. The zone consists of soda granite in albitite dykes.

Thirteen trenches have been completed to date with visible gold  
noted. Fire assays received for the first trenches are as follows:

The new Maddy zone can be traced for 2,800 feet and is open to  
the north and to depth. A diamond drill is presently being mobilized  
to test veins at depth.

Development continues on the 800 level Peter vein drift, 1,000  
feet below the surface. The design for the tailings impoundment  
facilities have been completed by SRK-Robinson and submitted to  
government agencies. Detailed reclamation and mine plans have  
also been submitted. Initial start-up is scheduled for 1996. (SEE
