LATEST CYPRUS ASSAY RESULTS - Guildford H. Brett, president,  
Cusac Gold Mines Ltd.,

formerly Cusac Industries Ltd., and International Taurus Resources Inc. report the latest summary of drilling results on the property located near Cassiar in northwestern B.C. Recent drilling on the Cusac property has been on claims held by Cusac and Int'l Taurus; Cyprus Canada can earn up to a 70% interest in selected areas.

Cyprus Canada, operator, reports the following results from holes T95-15 through T95-21. SEE DRILL HOLE MAP OVERLEAF P.2. Holes 18 and 21 stepped out 100 and 200 metres west of holes T95-3 (0.635 grams gold/tonne; 175.4 m.) and [T95-13 (0.523 g/t; 299.1 m.)] and intersected pyritic and pyritic quartz vein mineralization similar to that in the eastern holes. This indicates the mineralized system extends over a minimum east-west distance of 300 metres and dips eastward at about 25°. The lower section of pyritic mineralization in holes 3 and 13 appears to be present within the overall zone in the stepout holes; however, the geometry of the pyritic zone remains uncertain. Assay results are pending from a fence of north-south holes testing for a northerly extension of this mineralization.

Holes 19 and 20 were drilled in the vicinity of the old Taurus (Hearne) workings. Hole 19 intersected numerous zones of pyritic and pyritic quartz vein mineralization, including both steeply dipping vein zones and shallow east dipping pyritic fault zones. Hole 20, located 200 metres to the south, intersected only a narrow pyritic fault zone. Results are pending from follow-up drilling from this area, which has indicated the presence of complicating cross fault structures.

The assay results to date indicate the presence of mineralization grading better than 1 gram gold/tonne in most of the holes near section 12 West. Continued drilling is aimed at location and evaluation of significant widths of such mineralization within the main Taurus area. Holes 15 and 16 tested an IP chargeability feature in the southwest corner of the grid (the Mystery Mountain area), west of hole T95-12. Both holes intersected pyritic quartz vein mineralization similar to the main Taurus area, but did not define any zones greater than 1 gram gold/tonne. Hole 17 tested an IP chargeability feature south of the main Taurus area, coincident with major topographic high (History Hill). It intersected a narrow zone of pyritic quartz vein mineralization at depth, as well as several other weakly mineralized and altered zones.

Drilling is currently underway on hole T-40. Results of the most recent drilling will be forthcoming as they are received.

MORE GOOD GOLD ASSAYS RECEIVED - Guilford H. Brett,  
president of Cusac

Gold Mines Ltd., and International Taurus Resources Inc. report further assay results from drilling by Cyprus Canada Inc. The holes were completed on claims held by Cusac, Taurus optioned to Cyprus, near the town of Cassiar in north-central B.C. SEE DRILL HOLE MAP OVERLEAF P.1 THIS LETTER & OVERALL CLAIM MAP OVERLEAF P.2 IN GCNL NO.163, 24Aug95. The results indicate significant additional mineralization grading over 1 gram gold/tonne gold (0.03 oz/ton). Cyprus is earning a 50% interest in the respective companies' interests in certain areas and can earn a 70% interest by placing the properties into production.

Results continue to confirm the presence of a large area of gold mineralization over good widths and depths. Holes 22, 25 and 26 are in the area of the Taurus mine workings, while holes 24 and 27 are over 1 km. west. Hole T95-23 is located 250 metres west of T95-13.

Holes T95-23 and T95-25 were not mineralized and yielded no significant assay values and assays are still awaited for hole T95-26.

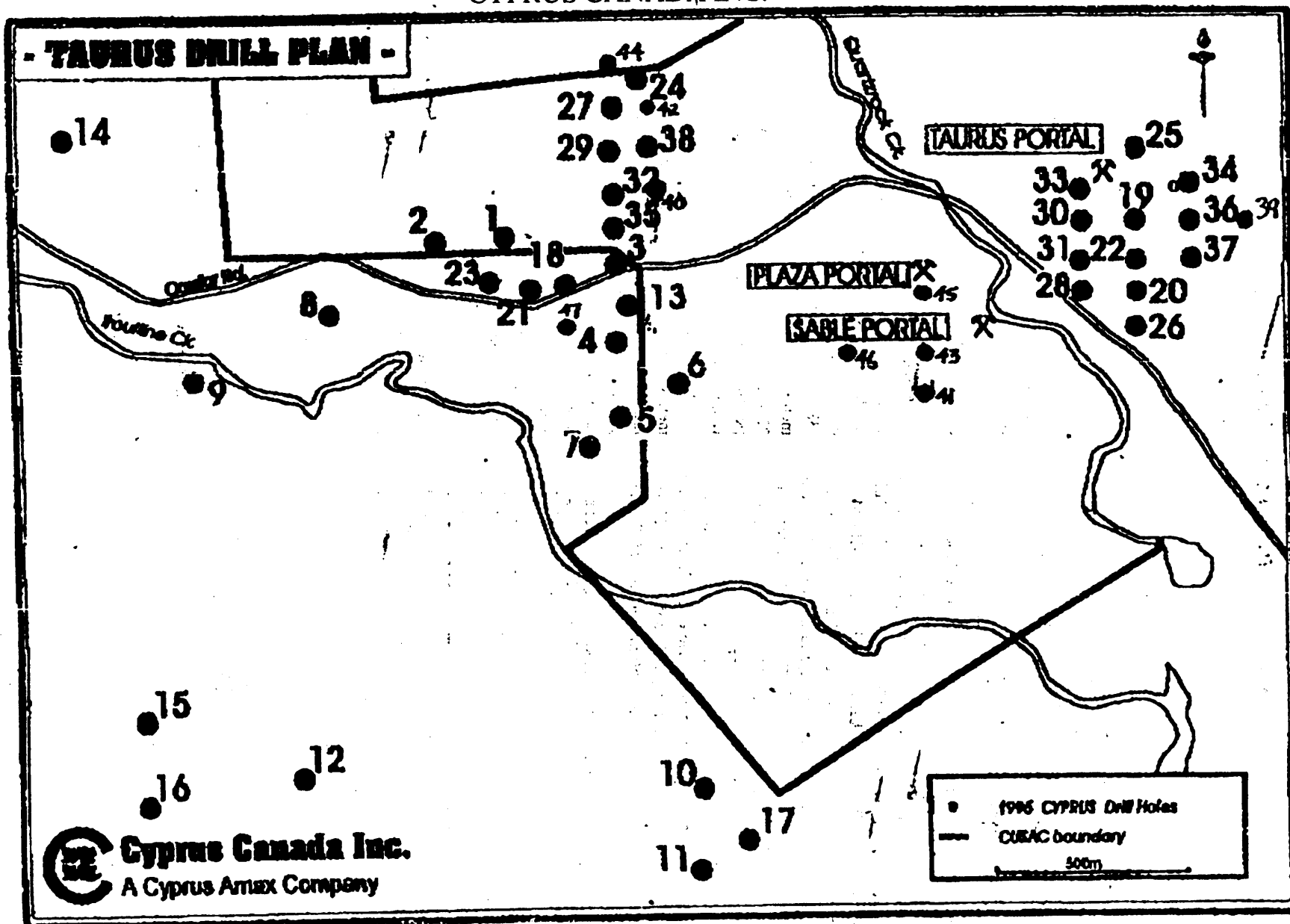
Results to date indicate the various areas of known mineralization may form one large, continuous deposit.

Cyprus has completed 47 drill holes to date. Broad zones of pyritic mineralization have been encountered in most of the presently unreported holes, for which assays are pending. Two diamond drills are currently at work on the project and a reverse circulation drill will be added shortly. (SEE GCNL NO.158, 17Aug95, P.1 FOR PREVIOUS CASSIAR DRILL RESULTS)
