1994 EXPLORATION ENCOURAGING - Irvin Eisler, president, reports G.W.R. Re-

sources Inc. carried out a work program on the Ann claims in its Lac La Hache project, Cariboo area, B.C. in the summer and fall of 1994. The company can earn a 65% interest in the Ann claims from Ophir Copper Corp. by spending \$125,000 on exploration and issuing 150,000 shares. The purpose of the program was mainly to fulfil underlying agreement requirements.

Results of the work completed were more encouraging than expected. Two holes were drilled on a weak induced polarization anomaly and a corresponding weak copper/gold soil geochemical anomaly. Drill hole A94-1 intersected several zones of elevated gold mineralization. In order from the collar, the results are:

Drillhole A94-2 was collared 200 metres west of hole A94-1 and returned 9 metres of 0.30 grams gold/tonne and 0.6 metres of 4.22 grams gold/tonne.

The section in hole A94-1 containing 11.41 grams gold/tonne over 3.8 metres occurs about 150 metres below a surface sample grading 1.98 grams gold/tonne over 2.5 metres, and appears associated with the contact of a quartz-feldspar porphyry dyke. Although the initial interest in the Ann claims was in copper, the elevated gold assay results are most encouraging. Further work on the claims will resume.
