HEARNE HILL PROJECT UPDATE - Hugh Grenfal, president, Booker Gold Explorations Ltd., reports the compilation of the data from the 1994 field season at the Hearne Hill project 65 km northeast of Smithers, B.C. is now being completed. Booker Gold has a 100% interest, subject to a 4% NSR, which can be bought out for cash or shares. The full results with a geological overview will be presented at the 1995 Cordilleran Roundup held at the Hotel Vancouver from February 7, 1995 to February 10, 1995. The Hearne Hill paper is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, February 9, 1995.

The diamond drill program has extended the Hearne Hill porphyry system over 800 feet (250 metres) beyond the previously mapped limits. More importantly, biotite alteration indicates the new drill holes are beginning to intersect a central zone in the system. This zone, an extension of the previously indicated 60,000,000 tons of 0.2% copper, is of much higher grade with associated gold values. The Hearne Hill porphyry copper/gold deposit is now open to the north and east with higher grade core, greater than 1% copper, with gold values. The holes drilled were all angle holes across the hillside to a length of 700 feet. Most holes bottom in mineralization relatively near the surface.

Drilling will resume to explore the stockwork/breccia core of the mineralized zone. The program is now well beyond the limits of any past geophysics or geochemistry. Further geochem and IP surveys are planned. In conclusion, the 1994 field season has extended the Hearne Hill porphyry and discovered a new high grade porphyry core.
