MORE MOLY CLAIMS ACQUIRED - Larry Reaugh, president, reports Amcorp Industries Inc. and Verdstone Gold Corp. have acquired an additional 4,500 acres of potential mineralized ground covering newly located showings at a yet-undisclosed location in B.C. This brings the joint holdings to a total of 6,000 acres and covers a mineralized east-west structure with visible molybdenum showings in the granodiorite at three places over 1.5 miles.

The companies will be opening the visible molybdenum showings by trenching to find out the extent and size of the mineralization. The visible showings are significant in that the granodiorite looked barren (leached) at the surface, but once the rock was broken a few inches in depth, visible globs of molybdenum were observed. Discovery Consultants reported assays as follows:
