HEN PROJECT UPDATE - Greg Amor, president, Double Creek Mining Corp., reports FARMOUT SOUGHT results of its 1,999 foot, six hole diamond drill program on the Hen property, located north of the town of Horsefly about 80 km east of Williams Lake, Cariboo Mining Division, B.C. Double Creek can earn an interest by paying \$137,500 and issuing 300,000 shares, subject to a 2.5% net smelter return royalty.

Sulphide mineralization intersected in drill holes 1 through 5 was predominantly pyrrhotite with lesser chalcopyrite and pyrite. All intrusive-sediment contacts are predominantly favourable for sulphide mineralization but the brownish porphyry is especially favourable and the porphyry itself can also host sulphide veinlets and masses in late fracture systems. Mineralized zones also occur within the siliceous greenish siltstone at the boundary with the less reactive argillite. The best intercepts include:
