## SABLE RESOURCES LTD.

[SAE-V] 4,095,907 SHS.

TOODOGGONE DRILLING TO START - Melvyn Rahal, president, reports in the fall of 1994, Sable Resources Ltd. completed a 5,000-foot drill program on its gold-silver property located in the Toodoggone area of northwest B.C. The main consideration of this program was to define at least 70,000 to 100,000 tons of ore reserves on three previously drilled targets - the JM, the Rainier and the Creek zones. Previous mining in 1989 - 1991 from this area of interest produced 117,000 tons of ore grading 0.20 oz.gold/ton and 9.11 oz.silver/ton.

The Creek zone provided the most encouraging results of the program which two holes encountering the mineralized zone. D.D. Hole 94-18 assayed 0.516 oz. gold/ton and 24.55 oz.silver/ton over a 12.5-foot width and D.D. Hole 94-20 assayed 0.630 oz.gold/ton and 9.86 oz.silver/ton over a 8.5-foot width.

Beginning June 23, a drill program will start to test this new zone of enriched mineralization. The zone is open to the north with no previous drilling in this area.

The company owns the former Du Pont flotation mill which is capable of processing over 250 tons per day and will be used to mill any newly defined reserves. The mill is eight km from the claims.

The company has retained a 2.5% net smelter return on the former Sable claims in the Cassiar area of northern B.C., now owned by INTERNATIONAL TAURUS RESOURCES INC. [ITU-V]. In 1994, Taurus carried out a successful exploration program indicating the potential for a large low grade gold deposit. Cyprus Amax has joint ventured this property with Taurus and the most recent drill results suggest the deposit is in the order of several hundred millions of tons.
