FILED PROGRAMS UNDERWAY - Len J. Harris, president, reports

Guardian Enterprises Ltd. has begun its 1995 field exploration programs on two of its projects. A program of intensive prospecting, sampling, mapping and staking began mid-May on the company's Wolf claims located on the Iskut River between the Snip mine and the Eskay Creek mine. A thorough investigation is being made on two electro-magnetic anomalies discovered by Newmont Mining in the 1960's and another electro-magnetic anomaly discovered in the 1980's by a junior mining company. Showings of copper-gold-silver and zinc are reported associated with these anomalies. Exploration located at a higher elevation on the two-km long gold-copper-silver-zinc shear zone will begin in July.

In Wyoming, Guardian has begun its 1995 exploration program designed to locate the source of large quantities of diamond indicator minerals of kimberlitic origin. The company has expanded its area of interest as a result of late 1994 results. Recent laboratory probe tests have been encouraging.
