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## PACIFIC VANGOLD MINES LTD.

BULK SAMPLE PERMIT RECEIVED/- Dal S. Brynelsen, president, HIGH GRADE EVENING STAR ASSAYS reports Pacific Vangold Mines Ltd. has received a

10,000-ton bulk sampling permit from the B.C. Provincial Government for its 100%-owned Evening Star Mine. The Evening Star Mine is located in the North Belt property at Rossland, southcentral B.C., adjacent to the Le Roj Mine that produced 3,000,000 ounces of gold at the turn of the century.

Initial diamond drilling completed between 1986 and the present has produced drill indicated reserves of 100,000 tons grading 0.3 oz. gold/ton. Underground mine development underway has potentially upgraded both the grade and tonnage. The raise and cross cut developed by the company from the main haulageway produced an average grade of 1.27 oz.gold/ton over a vein width of 15 feet. Pacific Vangold is now drifting on a two shift per day basis testing the length of this vein. The company has received much higher assays than originally anticipated from the surface drilling undertaken between 1986 and the present. Samples taken from each six-foot round in this drift have assayed as follows:

Pacific Vangold Mines also reports metallurgical testing has been completed and Evening Star ore will be shipped to Echo Bay's Mill, Republic, Washington. Over the next four weeks mine development work will create a stockpile of 1,500 tons of high grade ore. Daily shipments of about 100 tons per day will then start.
