BIG VALLEY RESOURCES INC. (BV-ALBERTA)

LLOYD-NORDIK DRILL RESULTS - Lloyd Tattersall, president, reports Big Valley Resources Inc. has received results from ongoing geophysical surveys and diamond drilling on the 100%-owned Lloyd-Nordik property located 65 km east of Williams Lake, B.C.

Early 1995 diamond drilling has confirmed the extension of the copper/gold mineralization on the Lloyd target, discovered during the 1994 field season. Step-out drilling on 50-metre intervals has expanded the width of this zone with the intersection of near surface mineralization in diamond drill holes 95-14, 95-15 and 95-16. Diamond drill hole 95-17 which is nearing completion, has intersected similar sulphide mineralization. Continued drilling is planned to fully examine the open pit potential of this zone.

Ground magnetic surveys have recently been completed on portions of the Lloyd 1 and Nordik 4 claim groups. These surveys have identified magnetic highs in both areas. Interpretation of the results suggests the magnetic highs on the Nordik 4 claim group may represent a south easterly extension of the known mineralization on Imperial Metals Corp.'s Mount Polley property immediately

adjoining the Nordik 4 claim block. The portion of this magnetic anomaly located on the Nordik 4 claim has a strike length of about 800 metres.

A number of magnetic anomalies have also been located on the Lloyd 1 claim and may represent a second area of significant mineralization. Big Valley will continue work on the property and plans to carry out a \$1,000,000 program in 1995. Negotiations in regard to the property are currently ongoing.
