MYRA FALLS METAL DISCOVERY - Bruce McKnight, vice president, corporate affairs, Westmin Resources Ltd., reports a second hole drilled into the North Downdrop region from the Lynx Mine, part of its Myra Falls mining complex, Vancouver Island, B.C., has encountered high-grade ore within H-W type stratigraphy. The hole has encountered multiple zones, two of which are detailed below and more are still being assayed.

The new discovery, which is in the North Downdrop region, has been named the Marshall Zone after Westmin's chairman. It is located within H-W age stratigraphy, but is different geologically - more like the Ridge East Zone. The tonnage implications are significant as this is the first ore in this region found north of the North-Downdrop fault. It is also situated above the H-W haulage level about 900 metres northwest of the current Battle Zone development. More assays will be released when available.
