CARIBOO DRILLING CONTINUES - William Jackson, director, Noble Metal Group Inc.,

reports the completion of diamond drill program hole No.1 to a depth of 153 feet at the 100%-owned J1 claim group located near the confluence of Snowshoe and Keithley Creeks in the Cariboo Mining

Division about 70 miles east of Williams Lake, B.C. This shallow hole was designed to test the strike and dip of Anomaly A. The hole intersected intermittent sections containing sulphide mineralization and quartz veins over an interval of 100 feet in various rock types including phyllite, quartzite and andesite.

Drill hole No.2 is currently being drilled to test the high induced polarization readings encountered in the recent survey. At present, the hole has intersected over 100 feet containing semi-massive to massive sections of sulphide mineralization consisting of pyrite, pyrrhotite, chalcopyrite, arsenopyrite, hematite and limonite. It is well documented that in the Cariboo Gold Belt, copper, gold, nickel and platinum are known to be associated with this type of mineralization.
