Booker Gold Explorations Ltd., has updated the diamond drill program on the 100%-owned Hearne Hill project, 65 km northeast of Smithers, B.C. Hole 95-17 was abandoned at 150 feet. Hole 95-18 was drilled at a 70° degree angle, bearing 340° from the site of No.95-16. Hole 95-19 was drilled from the same site at a 60° angle, azimuth 90°. Both of these holes were drilled to 1,000 feet and cut Hornfels volcanics with biotite, copper mineralization consisted of chalcopyrite on fractures.

Diamond drill hole 95-20 was drilled vertically from a site 50 metres to the north of 95-16. This hole intersected siliceous volcanics, breccia, and bottomed in biotite feldspar porphyry with good secondary biotite alteration. This hole was well mineralized with chalcopyrite on fractures and finely disseminated throughout the porphyry.

Diamond drill hole 95-21 is currently being drilled from the same site as diamond drill Hole 95-16 at a 70° angle to the southwest to check a geochemical anomaly. The hole has intersected wellmineralized breccia to a depth of 100 feet and will be extended to 1,000 feet. Mineralization consists of pyrite, chalcopyrite, tetrahedrite, and chalcocite.
