SECOND DRILL FOR STRIKE CLAIMS - Eric Gilstead, president, Navarre Resources

Corp., reports a second diamond drill is being mobilized to the 100%-owned strike claims located 18 miles north of Stewart, B.C. The second diamond drill is expected to arrive on the property the weekend of September 23. The new diamond drill will be used for an expanded work program.

Four holes have been completed to depths ranging from 450 to 830 feet. As of September 19, the drill was on hole No.5 at a depth of 300 feet. The drill will be moved to the hole No.6 location shortly. The current drill is running 24 hours per day to complete the balance of 15 holes from the 20-hole program on the Eskay Creek type target.

Management is encouraged by the drilling results to date and has therefore decided to order the mobilizing of a second diamond drill to the property immediately. Significant visual mineralization has been intersected in all drill holes to date. The mineralization is characterized by blebs and crystals. Logging and sampling to date has identified an impressive massive sulphide intercept with mineralization running into the wall rock on both side in hole No.2.

Mineralized intersections vary from 20 to 90 feet in thickness. These zones are accompanied by massive quartz, quartz flooding and microvein quartz stockworks. Sulphides occur in both veinlets and matrix and are described as disseminated to semi-massive to massive sulphides. Some intersections are accompanied by elevated chalcopyrite levels and historically, on this property, when higher levels of copper are encountered then the gold grade improve dramatically.

Detailed core splitting and sampling is underway. Assays will be reported on all mineralized zone as they are received. (SEE GCNL NO.180, 19Sept95, P.5 FOR PREVIOUS STRIKE PROJECT DATA)
