## INTERNATIONAL TAURUS RESOURCES INC.

## CUSAC GOLD MINES LTD.

GEOLOGIC RESOURCE INCREASED - David Hjerpe, president, International Taurus Resources Inc., and partner Cusac Gold Mines Ltd. report further encouraging assay results from the latest drill holes on the Taurus/Cusac project near Cassiar, northern B.C. Under agreements with the companies, Cyprus Canada Inc. is exploring certain areas to earn a 50% interest.

With about one-third of the current drill program yet to be drilled and/or completed, the companies' geologic resource estimate for the project stands at 3,800,000 ounces of gold.

Twelve drill hole results were reported. All holes have gold mineralization over widths ranging from 32 to 130 metres (105 to 426 ft.). The highest grade assay results are in the area between the 88-1 zone and the Sable portal, on line 6W. Hole 95-46 has 111 metres (364 ft.) of gold mineralization averaging 0.99 grams gold/tonne (0.029 oz/ton), which includes an interval of 55 metres (180 ft.) of 1.59 grams gold/tonne (0.046 oz/ton). Hole 95-48 has gold mineralization over a width of 130 metres (426 ft.) averaging 0.94 grams gold/tonne (0.027 oz/ton), with four significant intervals of 12.5 metres of 1.17 grams gold/tonne (0.034 oz/ton), 5.7 metres of 9.08 grams gold/tonne (0.265 oz/ton), 18 metres of 1.13 grams gold/tonne (0.033 oz/ton), and 10 metres of 1.58 grams gold/tonne (0.046 oz/ton). Hole 95-43 has gold mineralization over 54 metres (177 ft.) averaging 1.42 grams gold/tonne (0.041 oz/ton). This appears to be one promising area for a starter-pit, which would have to be confirmed with much closer spaced drilling (eg. 25 to 50 metres). In the east-west direction the drill holes are currently separated by 200 metres. (656 ft.).

In the Taurus West area along line 1100W, hole 95-44, about 200 metres (656 ft.) north of hole 95-29 (previously reported) intersected 86 metres (282 ft.) of 0.88 grams gold/tonne (0.026 oz/ton). This section 1100W is also shaping up as a promising area with wide higher grade intervals.

Hole 95-47 and 95-50 are on the Cusac property, 100 metres and 200 metres west of line 1100W, respectively. Hole 95-47 cut 88 metres (289 ft.) of gold mineralization averaging 0.61 grams gold/tonne (0.018 oz/ton), with 30 metres (98 ft.) of 0.93 grams gold/tonne (0.027 oz/ton), while hole 95-50 cut 56 metres (184 ft.) of gold mineralization averaging 1.03 grams gold/tonne (0.03 oz/ton). These widths and grades (in the 1.0 grams gold/tonne range) are considered to be favourable for a potential large tonnage, open pit mine.

Calculations by an independent consultant hired by Taurus and Cusac estimates that, to date, the project hosts at least 130,000,000 tons averaging 0.029 oz. gold/ton (1.0 g/t), thus containing at least 3,800,000 ounces of gold. This is up from the previously announced estimate of 100,000,000 tons and 2,900,000 ounces. The potential to increase this resource estimate significantly is considered to be favourable as many promising areas have yet to be drilled.

Cyprus Canada Inc. is continuing with a drilling and exploration program. The current drill program has completed 67 drill holes to date, and anticipates a reprieve in drilling in early

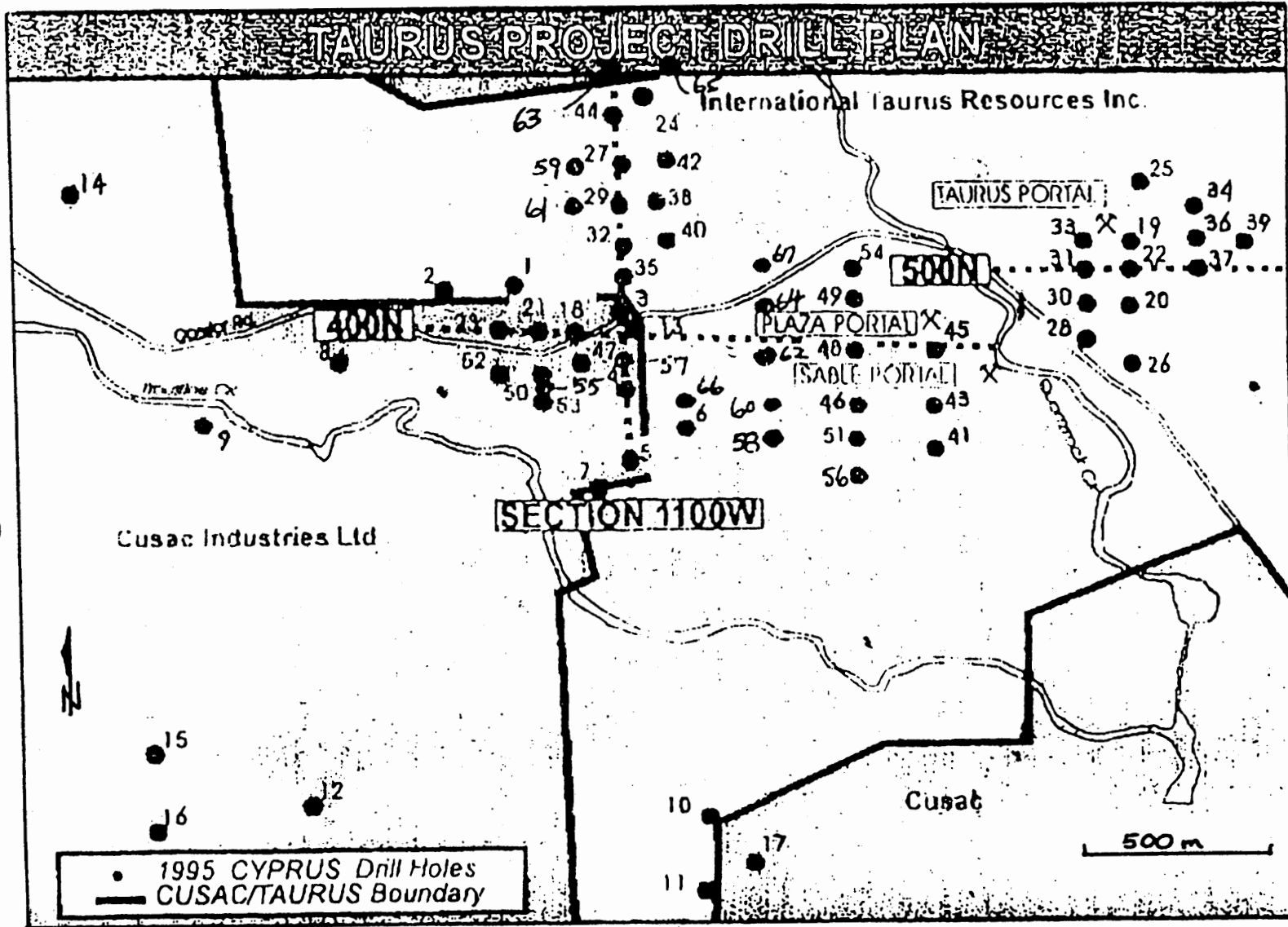
October, so assay results can catch up to the drill program and additional metallurgical tests can be conducted. Cyprus may continue close-space drilling during the winter in the most promising areas. Results for the most recent drilling will be announced as they are received. SEE MAP OVERLEAF P. 1.
