SIBOLA DRILLING REPORT - Victor J.E. Jones, president, Westley Technologies Ltd. has reported assay results from four diamond drilling holes on its optioned Sibola porphyry copper prospect located 70 km south of Houston, B.C. and 20 km northeast of the Huckleberry deposit. The assays identify a low grade mineralized zone about 100 metres wide along a volcanic intrusive contact. The zone is coincident with a chargeability high from an induced polarization survey. The intrusion contact has been traced for one km east of the 1995 drill holes and is open.

The next phase of exploration is to include a more induced polarization survey, followed by diamond drilling.

A \$40,000 private placement reported earlier was cancelled and the WIT project has been allowed to lapse. The company is evaluating gold projects on the Pacific Rim for acquisition and waiting for complete analysis of exploration work carried out in 1995 on its claim in Labrador and the Northwest Territories.
