ANOTHER GOOD HEARNE HILL HOLE - Ms. S. Hallock, director, reports Booker Gold

Explorations Ltd. has received assays from drill hole DDH95-26 at the 100%-optioned Hearne Hill project 65 km east of Smithers. B.C. in the Babine Lake region. This hole is from the Potassic Zone on the western edge of the 1995 drill program. The hole was drilled away from the coincidental induced polarization chargeabilityresistivity anomaly. Booker also reports the start of the 1996 exploration program. The first crew has been sent to the property to prepare roads and drill sites. Drilling is expected to begin shortly with the completion of DDH95-32. The program will then move 500 metres to the southwest to drill test coincidental IP-geochemical anomalies.
