WATSON BAR DRILL RESULTS - Larry W. Reaugh, president,  
Stirrup Creek Gold Ltd.,

reports initial results from the diamond drilling program at the 70%-  
optioned Watson Bar gold project, located 33 km west of Clinton,  
BC. The holes are designed to test the down-dip extension of the  
previously reported high grade trench. The property has the  
potential to host Carlin-type deposits such as large tonnage low  
grade intercepts (as evidenced in hole No.96-01) grading between  
0.02 to 0.05 oz.gold/ton and high grade ore shoots (as evidenced in  
hole No. 89-01) as follows:

Some of the larger open pit Carlin-type mines grade in the area of 0.019 to 0.022 oz.gold/ton. Soil sampling results from an area 250 metres below and east of Zone V have returned values ranging up to 1,000 ppb gold. Trenching is slated for this area later this week.
