 EXPLORATION OF HIGH GRADE- Larry W. Reaugh, president has GOLD UNDERWAY reported Stirrup Creek Gold Ltd. has started excavator trenching, soil sampling and geological work on the 100% owned high grade Watson Bar gold project, 33 km. west of Clinton, BC.

 The diamond drilling will start June 20, 1996.

A 100-ton samlpe processed at Silbak Premier Mill near Stewart, BC returned 1.16 oz/ton gold.

Recent metallurgical testing on a one ton sample averaging 1.87 oz/ ton gold has returned preliminary results as follows:

"A positive indication that much of the gold is free: this initial test at a very coarse grind of 100% minus 28 mesh produced a concentrate containing 46.5 oz/ton gold and 44.5 oz/ton silver. Gold recovery was 68.8%. Further tests at finer grinds are underway to determine the maximum amount of free gold which can be recovered by simple means prior to the usual methods involving flotation and cyanidation. The 100 ton bulk sample through the cyanide mill circuit at Premier gave an overall recovery of 94%."
