EXPLORATION RESUMED - Big Valley Resources has resumed exploration work on the Lloyd-Nordik copper property, 60 km east of

Williams Lake, B.C. Over the past month a trenching program has seen carried out to test a number of geochemical anomalies identified luring the 1995 field surveys. Two of the recent trenches, 750 metres apart, contained disseminated chalcopyrite, bornite and pyrite.

The recent trenching has identified a number of drill targets within an area of 300 metres by 1,000 metres. The diamond drill equipment is on the property and crews will be mobilized in the near future.

Additional drilling will also be carried out on the Lloyd 2 target. This drilling will test the extent and continuity of the zone of 0.392 oz/ ton gold zone intersected in diamond drill hole 94-16.

The company also announced Montgomery Consultants Ltd. of Vancouver are finalizing an ore reserve calculation for the Lloyd-Nordik property. Future drilling will focus on those areas indicating potential for increasing reserve grades and tonnage.
