WATSON BAR GOLD VALUES CONFIRMED - Larry W. Reaugh,

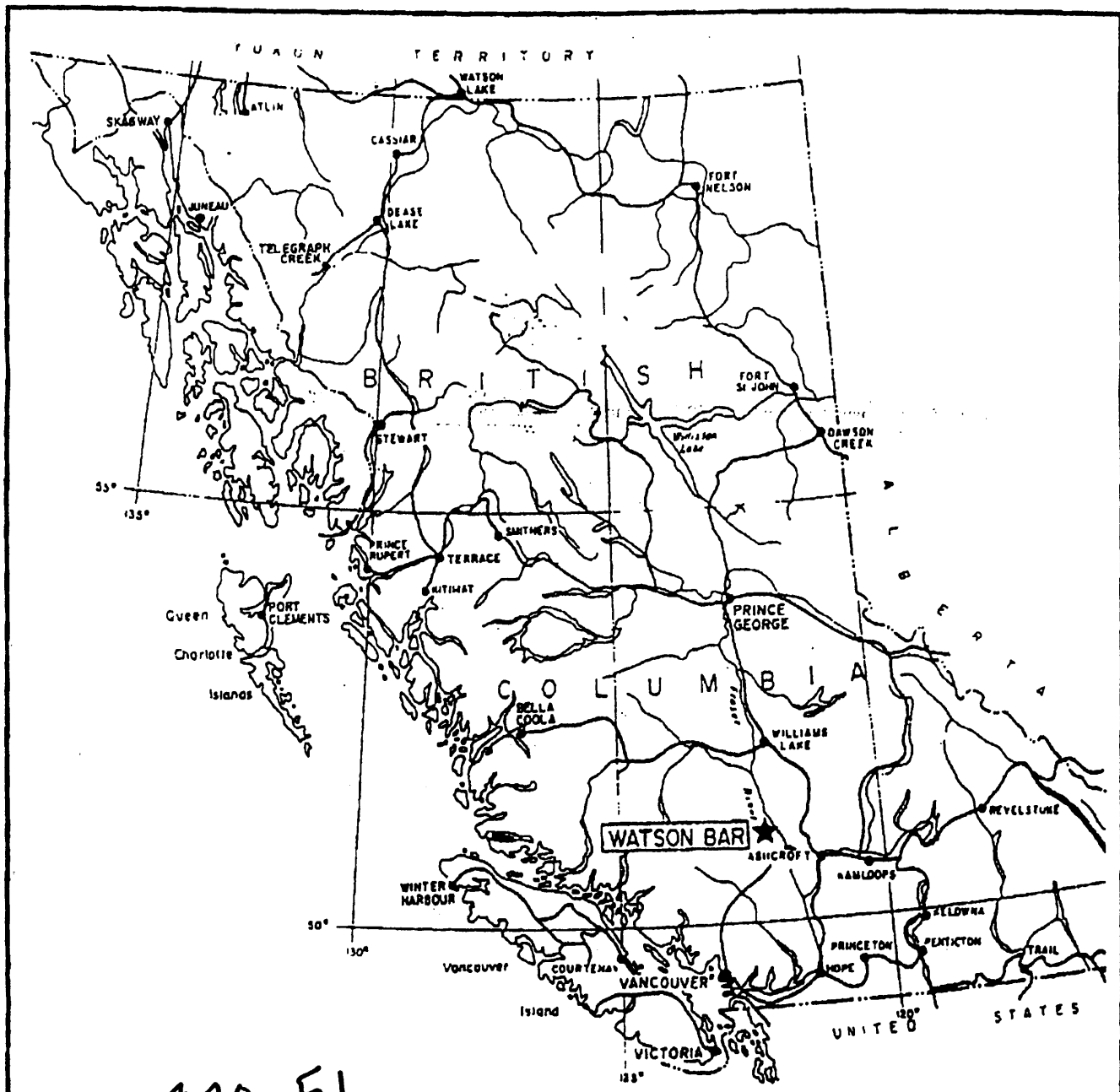
Creek Gold Ltd., reports Burton Consulting has confirmed the high grade potential of the 70%-optioned Watson Bar Gold prospect 33 km due west of Clinton, southwest BC. SEE MAPS OVERLEAF PAGES 1 & 2 IN GCNL NO.87, 3May96. A sample taken over 1.2 feet in hanging wall material averaged 3.083 oz.gold/ton and 3.45 oz.silver/ton. Directly below this sample, a sample of mixed quartz vein averaged 1.826 oz.gold/ton and 3.10 oz.silver/ton over 3.3 feet for a weighted average of 2.159 oz.gold/ton over 4 feet 5 inches.

At the time of the examination, the vein was partially buried so the true width is unknown. Previous work established a surface strike length of at least 121 feet in this area. As previously reported, a

100-ton sample taken from this area averaged 1.16 oz.gold/ton.

The company is awaiting government approval to start exploration on this property which hosts the potential for Bonanza type orebodies. As well, previous drilling indicates a low-grade high-tonnage potential when a diamond drill hole drilled in 1991 returned 92 feet grading 0.027 opt gold.
