SOME ENCOURAGEMENT IN - Paul J. Weishaupt, the president of TOODOGGONE DRILLING Canasil Resources Inc., has reported as part of the 1996 exploration on the Brenda property starting on July 11, 1996, three diamond drill holes have been completed for a total of 338.6 metres. The property is located in the Toodoggone-Kemess Gold camp, 28 km. north of the Kemess South gold-copper porphyry deposit under development by Royal Oak Mines Inc.

Holes 96-02 (131.97 metres) and 96-03 (75.89 metres) were drilled in the White Pass zone, where a gold-silver geochemical anomaly, 900 by 200 metres, has been outlined. Limited diamond drilling in this area has confirmed a gold-copper porphyry zone. As a result the area is considered to be a prime exploration target for a gold-rich porphyry copper deposit. The results of diamond drill holes in the White Pass area are as follows:

Hole 96-01 (130.75 metres) was drilled along Jock Creek, 2 km. east of the White Pass zone, to explore a strong IP anomaly. The hole intersected 121.5 metres of pyrite mineralization with anomalous copper and gold values. The best section, 7.5 metres in length, intersected 0.58 gpt gold and 0.11% copper. The extensive mineralization encountered confirms this area is a second potential gold rich porphyry copper deposit which merits further exploration.

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
