On the Lloyd-Nordik project 95 km northeast of Williams Lake, BC, drill holes 97-114 and 97-115 have extended the copper mineralization an additional 150 metres to the northwest. Final results for the drill holes 97-116 and 97-118 are pending and will be reported later. Drill hole 97-117 was a geological exploratory hole drilled 300 metres west of hole 97-116. To date, drilling has partially tested an area of mineralization showing consistent lateral and vertical copper grades. The area is still open to the northwest and southeast. Although the copper grade is low, geological interpretation of the alkalic porphyry system continues to show encouraging potential to host a major zone of copper-gold
