CHAPPELLE PROJECT UNDERWAY - Melvyn Rabal, president,
reports Sable Resources

Ltd. has started its \$400,000 exploration program on the Chappelle property located 30 miles north of Royal Oak's Kemess Mine in the Toodoggone area of north-central BC. The program will investigate several targets on the recently acquired mineral claims of Multinational Mining Inc., a private company, now a wholly owned subsidiary of Sable.

A field crew has been on site since early June carrying out road construction necessary for access to drill sites. The drilling program started on June 28 with an initial series of holes planned for the targets in close proximity of the nearby Multinational "B" deposit. A number of structures similar to those hosting the Vein A and B deposits were encountered during the earlier road construction. Vein A produced 95,000 tons and Vein B produced over 15,000 tons.

It is expected this systematic exploration program will prove up additional gold deposits which host high grade ore and provide mill feed for the company's Baker Mill adjacent to the property. In 1996, 2,500 tons of ore from the Multinational "B" vein generated revenues of about \$1,000,000. In addition, about 800 to 1,000 tons of ore grading 1 oz. gold/ton equivalent is available for extraction from the Multinational "B" open pit and will be processed this season. Four diamond drill holes have been completed to date. Assays results will be released when available.
