Resources ltd., reports a geostatistical resource estimate for the 100% owned Mac property has been completed by G.H. Giroux, P.Eng., M.Sc. of Giroux Consultants Ltd. The project is located in the Babine Lake region about 100 km east of Smithers, near Granisle, BC. The report confirms at a cut off grade of 0.06% MoS₂;

the indicated resource in the volcanics is 52,420,000 tonnes at an MoS₂ equivalent of 0.14% MoS₂, and the inferred resource is 47,520,000 tonnes at an MoS₂ equivalent of 0.12% MoS₂ for a total of about 100,000,000 tonnes indicated and inferred. Gross value of the resource at current market prices exceeds Cdn. \$1 billion.
