LLOYD-NORDIK DRILL RESULTS - Lloyd Tattersall, president, Big Valley Resources Inc., reports preliminary results from drilling is outlining the extent of the new copper discovery on the 100% owned Lloyd-Nordik project 95 km northeast of Williams Lake, BC.

Four additional exploratory vertical drill holes have been completed to a depth of 700 feet each. A fifth vertical drill hole (DH97-111) was abandoned at 109 feet due to water flooding in a fault. Drill hole 97-109, collared 77 metres southeast of DH97-99, intersected 328 feet of fine grained, disseminated chalcopryite, grading 0.16% copper and 0.03 grams gold/tonne. The central segment of mineralization in DH97-109 was continuous for 190 feet and graded 0.25% copper and 0.04 grams gold/tonne, including two 6.5 feet intervals of 0.50% copper and 0.53% copper.

The drilling has confirmed the presence of an alkalic porphyry system of intrusion breccias and extensive zones of potassic alteration. Low grade copper mineralization of potentially large volume is indicated within a zone open to the northwest and southeast. Exploration drilling continues on the Lloyd-Nordik project.
