## LYSANDER GOLD CORP.

JAYJAY EXPLORATION REPORT - Arthur T. Fisher, president.

Lysander Gold Corp., reports results of its 1997 diamond drill and reconnaissance soil sampling programs carried out in September on the Jajay project 93 miles north of Fort St. James, north-central BC. Over the past two years, Lysander has acquired rights over the properties lying within the roughly circular geological structure of the Jajay Ring. Lysander believes these are attractive copper and gold prospects.

The program significantly extended the zone of mineralization identified by earlier drill programs on the Bishop Zone of the

Lorraine property and identified a high grade core of mineralized material containing significant copper and gold (with grades of up to 2.5% copper and 3.7 grams gold/tonne in hole L97-47).

The results of the two best holes on the Bishop Zone are shown OVERLEAF P.1. Hole L97-47 is located some 230 metres to the north-northeast of hole L97-44, both in the Bishop Zone, and hence there is potentially a substantial volume of mineralized material in this area. The principal mineral is bornite.

A soil and talus sampling program was carried out in the south-east of Jajay and identified several areas of interest which will require future follow-up drilling. Boulder samples recovered from talus materials carried up to 4.9% copper and 6.5 grams gold/tonne. Again, the mineral of principal interest in these samples is bornite. The immediate source of this talus material has not yet been identified.

Reconnaissance drilling programs completed on the Dorothy Claims and on the Pal Claims, also in the south and south-east of Jajay, identified targets for follow-up drilling in 1998.

Encouraged by the September drilling program, the company is now compiling and evaluating information from this and prior years' drill and geochemical programs, which will be used for planning and preparation of an extensive exploration program in 1998.

The program will include further drilling on the Bishop Zone to delineate the extent and grade of the mineralization on that Zone, for possible ore reserve calculations and for prefeasibility planning purposes; as well as investigation of other areas within the Jajay Ring.
